**III. COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

**1. Credentials:**

Dr. Charles Neidorff - Application for New Jersey dental license. Data Bank shows one malpractice settlement in 1996. The committee recommends that he supply information about the settlement reported on the Data Bank

Dr. Samer Khoury - Application for a New Jersey dental license. Dr. Khoury completed the WREB in 2004, and has been actively licensed since 2004, but has not practiced in one state for at least 5 years. The Board determined that he must either take the NERB or finish 5 years of practice in Pennsylvania.

Catherine Bercier, RDH - Application for a dental hygiene license. The Board reviewed additional concerning the CITA exam she completed. The committee recommends approval of license.

Jennifer Sullivan, RDH - Application for a dental hygiene license. The committee recommends approval of license.

The Board in a motion by Dr. Cappetta, seconded by Ms. Birenz, approved the recommendations of the committee.

## **IV. APPEARANCES: (Before a committee)**

1. 1:00 P.M. - Dr. Raymond Pacholec - Request for reinstatement of license. Dr. Pacholec entered an interim consent order of voluntary surrender of licensure on May 1, 2009 following an arrest in March 2009. He appeared with Dr. Edward Reading of the PAPNJ to discuss the current status of his case. At the conclusion of Dr. Pacholec's testimony and questions from the Board, it was determined to reinstate Dr. Pacholec's license with the conditions recommended by the Professional Assistance Program. Dr. Pacholec will have to provide proof of completion of the required continuing education credits prior to reinstatement.
2. 1:30 P.M. - Dr. Jonathan Friedman - Request for reinstatement of license. Dr. Friedman entered a consent order of voluntary surrender of licensure on April 21, 2010 following the receipt of information that Dr. Friedman had used CDS for a non-medical or dental purpose. He appeared with Dr. Edward Reading of the PAPNJ to discuss the current status of his case. At the conclusion of Dr. Friedman's testimony and questions from the Board the matter was moved to Executive Session for discussion. The Board tabled this matter; additional information will be obtained.
