THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE FROM THE OCTOBER 31, 2012 AGENDA WHICH WAS CANCELED BECAUSE OF WHEATHER CONDITIONS:

I. APPROVAL OF MINUTES: October 17, 2012 - Approved as amended.

II. COMMITTEE REPORTS:

1. Applications:

Dr. Foujan Maghsoudi - Request for reinstatement of her dental license. His New Jersey license expired in 2003; she has been actively practicing in New York. The Board determined that Dr. Maghsoudi must take and pass the DSCE part of NERB and pay the back fees to reinstate. He must also provide proof of 80 hours of continuing education credits.

Dr. Rebecca Bockow - Application for a dental license by credentials. Passed the WREB, but has not been practicing for five years in one jurisdiction. She must either successfully complete the NERB exam, or complete five years of experience in one jurisdiction to satisfy regulatory requirements.

NOTE: The Board in a motion by Dr. Feinberg, seconded by Dr. DeRobertis, requested that the regulations committee discuss amending the regulation N.J.A.C. 13:30-1.2(d) concerning approved clinical examinations.

Dr. Eric Oh - Application for a dental license. Dr. Oh took the WREB exam and has been practicing dentistry in New York since 2006. The Board approved this application.

Sonia A. Grant - Request for permission to take the "State Only" NERB exam for dental hygiene in Florida. Ms. Grant did not graduate from a CODA approved program in dental hygiene. Ms. Grant does not qualify for a dental hygiene license in New Jersey.

Kimberly Windl - Inquiry concerning requirements for dental hygiene license. Ms. Windl has not practiced since 2004. The Board determined that Ms. Windl must take the refresher course and pass the JP exam.

2. **Continuing Education:**

The committee reported on eight courses for continuing education and recommends approval of all eight courses.

Wendel Family Dental - Application for an 80 hour course in moderate sedation with multiple oral and parenteral agents. The Board determined that additional information be obtained including a detailed course outline/syllabus. A copy of the Board's regulation 13:30-8.2(d) outlining the requirements will be sent.

III. PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

1. A-3394 - Authorizes professional and occupational boards to recognize continuing education approval entities. The Board supports this legislation.

IV. REPORTS SUBMITTED PURSUANT TO N.J.A.C. 13:30-8.8:

1. Dr. Sifia C. Carram - This matter was moved to executive session. Upon return to public session, the matter was received as informational.

V. PROVISIONAL ORDER OF DISCIPLINE TO BE FINALIZED:

1. Dr. Bruce Speiser - The Board reviewed the Provisional Order of Discipline filed on September 19, 2012, and served on Dr. Speiser. Dr. Speiser did not submit any a response to this Order. The Board in a motion by Dr. Cappetta, seconded by Dr. DeRobertis, determined to finalize the Order as drafted.

VI. ORDERS FILED WITH THE BOARD:

1. Dr. Joseph Rozehzadeh - Consent Order filed on October 3, 2012. This was taken as informational.

VII. OTHER MATTERS:

1. Inquiry from Jennifer Font, Digital Sales Specialist, Henry Schein, questioning whether “its ok for dental assistants to capture intraoral pictures for CAD/CAM procedures.” The Board noted that currently, this procedure is not within the scope of practice. Registered dental assistants are permitted to take alginate impressions only.

NOTE: This matter will be referred to the regulations committee for discussion to include this procedure in the scope of practice.

2. Letter from the Commission on Dental Accreditation concerning state board participation on accreditation site visits. The names of Dr. DeRobertis and Deputy Attorney General Swang Oo will be submitted for consideration.
3. NERB - Information concerning the 2013 Annual Meeting. This was received a informational.
4. Board Meeting Dates for 2013 - The Board changed the January 2013 meeting dates to January 2nd and January 16th.

VIII. PUBLIC COMMENT:

Dr. Roshong from the New Jersey Dental Association directed the following questions to the Board:

- Can a dental hygienist be a share holder in a corporation that owns a dental practice under the Board's regulation N.J.A.C. 13:30-8.13. DAG Miller indicated that she is currently reviewing this matter.
- Request for an update on the Beach Bum Tanning. The Board noted that the investigation continues.
- Delta Dental has updated their computer system, which cannot accept the full license number issued by the Board of Dentistry which includes "22DI". The Board noted that those prefixes are used for the Board's use and does not change the actual numbers in the license.

IX. ADJOURNMENT: The Board adjourned the Public Session and moved to Executive Session for advice of counsel and review of open matters (investigations and deliberations). When and if action is taken, it will be reported in Public Session.
