**B. COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

**1. Pending Applications**

Konstantin Maltsen, DDS - Application for a New Jersey dental license by reciprocity. Dr. Maltsen meets all requirements for licensure. The committee recommends approval.

Michael Goldman, DDS - Application for a New Jersey dental license by NERB past five years. Dr. Goldman meets all requirements for licensure. The committee recommends approval.

Michael Bundy, DMD - Application for a New Jersey dental license by reciprocity. Dr. Bundy meets all requirements for licensure. The committee recommends approval.

The Board in a motion by Dr. Cappetta, seconded by Ms. Leach, approved the committee's recommendations.

**C. SECRETARY'S REPORT:**

The Board in a motion by Ms. Leach, seconded by Ms. Delaney, approved the list of applicants for licensure.

**D. LEGISLATIVE REPORT:**

1. A-3496 - The Board reviewed proposed legislation concerning "Health and Dental Claims Authorization,

Processing and Payment Act." After discussing this matter, the Board in a motion by Dr. Rosenheck, seconded by Dr. Feinberg, supported the concept of this bill and await further information on this issue.

#### E. OTHER MATTERS:

1. AADE - The Board reviewed Letters concerning the development of a uniform national dental and dental hygiene licensure examination which would be recognized for completing the clinical examination requirements for all states. The Board took this as informational.
2. Duane C. Keller, DMD - The Board reviewed a letter concerning "Great First Impression Method of Treating Periodontal Disease." During discussion of this matter the Board noted that it is not appropriate to endorse devices. The Board was not provided with scientific literature regarding the efficacy of this product. The brochure may be misleading, copy of the advertising regulations will be sent to Dr. Keller.
3. Dianne Magnani, RDH - The Board reviewed an inquiry questioning whether the use of "Oraqix" a topical anesthetic is within the scope of practice of a registered dental hygienist. An article entitled "Controlling the Pain" was also reviewed. The Board in a motion by Ms. Delaney, seconded by Ms. Leach, determined that the use of this topical anesthetic falls within the scope of practice of a dental hygienist.
