I. APPROVAL OF MINUTES: February 17, 2010 - Approved as amended.

II. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

- Executive Director Jonathan Eisenmenger reported to the Board that he will be speaking
to the dental students at UMDNJ on March 24, 2010.

III. COMMITTEE REPORTS:

1. Credentials:

- Erica Disney, RDA - Application for registered dental assistant. The committee
requested that additional information be obtained with regard to an action she did not
disclose on her application.

- Dr. Yoon Kang - Application for a New Jersey dental license. Dr. Kang took the
WREB exam which, at the time taken, was comparable to NERB. The committee
recommended approval.

2. Continuing Education:

- The committee recommended approval of six courses and requested additional information on three.
- The committee discussed an online CPR course. The committee recommends that the sponsor be requested to provide additional information about this course. The Board requested this be clarified in Sunset.
- Camden County College submitted a new Registered Dental Assistant course. The course is 39 hours in length. The committee recommends approval as a "short course". The Board requested "short course" vs. "long course" be clarified in Sunset.
- Remedial continuing education - The committee reviewed and recommended approval of two courses.

Upon motion made by Dr. Feinberg, seconded by Dr. DeScisio, approved the committee's recommendations.

The Board approved her RDA application and granted a three month extension to complete the continuing education credits. Ms. Mercante will also be required to retake the Law & Jurisprudence exam.
