7. For Advisory Committee Review

A. Bill No. A4479, June 1, 2015

Senate and General Assembly Bill No. 4479, an act that prohibits courts and professional boards from denying/revoking professional licenses to individuals because they are delinquent in paying child support.

B. Bill No. A4672, June 29, 2015

Senate and General Assembly Bill No. A4672, an act that repeals suspension of certain licenses for failure to repay student loans, as well as, suspension of licenses of attorneys, who fail to repay student loans, by the Supreme Court of the State of New Jersey.
