8. Advisory Committee Review

Inquiry concerning In Duct Smoke Detectors

Review and discussion of an inquiry by Dan Danko, DanMor Mechanical, Inc., concerning installation of In Duct Smoke Detector forwarded by the Board of Heating, Ventilating, Air Conditioning and Refrigeration (HVACR) Contractors to the Advisory Committee. Mr. Danko questions whether a HVACR Contractor would be allowed to wire and install In Duct Smoke Detectors with remote stations as they are replacing units that are rated for 2000 cfm or higher to bring the project up to code. Therefore, Mr. Danko believes that Licensed HVACR Contractors are qualified to do this type of work, which so far is being done by a licensed electrician or licensed fire alarm company.

A motion was made by Mr. Eaves and seconded by Mr. Fury to advise Mr. Danko that if installation of In Duct Smoke Detector is used for Duct Management, there is no need to subcontract a licensed electrician installer or licensed fire alarm installer. However, if the In Duct Smoke Detectors are installed to a panel a licensed fire alarm installer is required. Motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Mr. Sprague and seconded by Mr. Fury to close the Public Session of the meeting at 10:45 a.m. and adjourn into Executive Session in order to discuss consumer complaints and potential disciplinary actions. Motion carried unanimously.
