### **II LICENSING EXAMINATION**

September 23, 2013 next licensing exam.

### **III NEW BUSINESS**

- a. Information received from the International Hearing Aid Society in regards to the recommended passing score of 53 (66.3%) for the new licensing examination.

### **IV LEGISLATION/REGULATION**

- b. For Committee review, Senate No. 2727 which establishes "Study Commission on E-Licensing".
- c. For Committee review, Senate No. 2842 which provides for similar requirements for minor and adult patients in medical marijuana program. This bill amends the "New Jersey Compassionate Use Medical Marijuana Act" to promote access to medical marijuana by severely ill children.
