This approval is based upon information supplied by the applicant at the time of application for certification. The game must be operated in accordance with the specifications submitted and the terms of this certification. GAME DESCRIPTION

Big Top Bop! is a single player cion operated redemption game. The game play area consists of a boxing glove on an extension and a clown face with light in a horseshoe pattern surrounding the clown face. The top center light is the "Win" light. The object of the game is to hit the clowns nose with the glove, which stops the moving light. The player actuates the glove punch by pressing the button in the center of the front panel. Stopping the light on the "Win " light awards the jackpot prize. If the player misses the "Win" light, tickets are awarded based on the ticket value associated with the light.

CONDITIONS

- 1.) The maximum price to play shall not exceed values set forth in N.J.A.C. 13:3-3.4.
- 2.) Payout must occur immediately upon a win.
- 3.) Game shall be clean and free of debris.
- 4.) Game shall be installed and maintained according to manufacturer specifications.

This certification is not a license to operate the captioned gambling device. The device may only be operated in a location specifically approved for the operation of amusement games pursuant to the Law and Regulations.

The Commission reserves the right to suspend, revoke or modify this certification upon notice to the manufacturer and/or applicant.
