The game named above is hereby granted a Certification of Permissibility for operation in New Jersey pursuant to the provisions of the Amusement Games Licensing Law, N.J.S.A. 5:8-100 et seq. ("Law"), and the regulations promulgated thereunder, N.J.A.C. 13:3-1.1 et seq. ("Regulations"). This approval is based upon information supplied by the applicant at the time of application for certification. The game must be operated in accordance with the specifications submitted and the terms of this certification. Any modification of the manufacturer's specifications or the specified method of play immediately voids this certification.

It is unlawful to license or operate any amusement game in the State of New Jersey without a valid Certification of Permissibility or in a manner not in accordance with Certification of Permissibility issued for the game. This Certification of Permissibility contains four pages. This is page 1 of 4.

**DESCRIPTION:**

Down the Drain Game is a attendant operated skill game. The “Down the Drain” is played when a single player tossing a ball onto the game board which, holes have been cut and tubed inserts have been placed into a hole or several holes to prevent the tossed ball from falling through the game board. A player wins upon the posted rules of play. See Conditions number 13 and 14 of this Certification of Permissibility for allowable methods of operations of this game.

**DEFINITIONS:**

“Game Board” means the platform(s) upon which the three color(s) holes are placed.

“Obstruction” means any portion of the stand/structure, any light or other type fixture, any box, bag, prize, fence or other material.

“Play field” means the area within the stand/structure in which the player is required to play the game.

“Prize Category” means a prize, or group of prizes of comparable value, available to a player upon completion of the task necessary to win a prize in a particular category or available to a player by “trade up.”

“Prize category designation” means the identifier of one of the six authorized prize categories prescribed by condition 10 of this Certification of Permissibility.

“Professional quality” means that the surface of the sign to be used must be smooth and rigid in nature and not made from paper or corrugated cardboard, unless laminated.

“Round of play” means the sale of a right to participate, the event which determines whether the player wins or loses and the award of the prize.

“Stand/structure” means any stand, structure, booth, tent, trailer or area in which the game is operated.

“Trade up” means trading multiple prizes of a lower prize category for a prize in a higher prize category.

**CONDITIONS:**

- 1.) The maximum price to play shall not exceed values set forth in N.J.A.C. 13:3-3.4.
- 2.) The play field shall be clear of all obstructions.
- 3.) The play field shall be contained within the area of the stand/structure in which the game is located.
- 4.) No merchandise shall be allowed in or around the stand/structure for display purposes only.
- 5.) All prizes displayed must be available to be won either in a single round of play or by trading up through continued play.
- 6.) A sign explaining prize category trade up requirements shall be conspicuously posted at all times during the operation of the game.
- 7.) The minimum size of a sign containing the statement required by condition number 6 of this certification shall be 8.5 inches x 11 inches. The sign shall be of professional quality and shall consist of block letters of at least .50 inches. The background and the letters of the sign shall be electronically displayed or permanently printed of contrasting colors.
- 8.) All prizes available through the play of the game shall be conspicuously displayed above the front counter height of the stand/structure.
- 9.) The maximum number of prize categories shall be six (6).
- 10.) Prize categories from the lowest to highest in values shall only be known, referred to, designated, or labeled as : Small; Medium; Large; X-Large; Jumbo or Choice.
- 11.) Prizes displayed shall be labeled to indicate prize category. Prizes shall be labeled individually or as a clearly delineated group of the same prize category.
- 12.) The maximum number of prizes required in order to trade up to the next higher prize category shall be three (3). (IE: Three Small prizes are required to trade up to one Medium prize. Three Medium prizes are required to trade up to one Large prize. Three Large prizes are required to trade up to one X-Large prize. Three X- Large prizes are required to trade up to one Jumbo prize. Three Jumbo prizes are required to trade up to one Choice prize.)
- 13.) An approved method of operating a glass less goblet toss game is: Inserts are placed into holes cut into the game board to prevent winning balls from falling through the game board. The player wins a prize when the ball rests in one of the inserts.

- 14.) An approved method of operating a glass less goblet toss game is: Inserts are placed into holes cut out into the game board to prevent winning balls from falling through the game board. Holes of various colors are cut into the game board. In accordance with the posted rules of play, the color of the hole in which the ball rests determines the category of the prize won.
  
- 15.) The balls used shall be equal in size, shape, weight and all other characteristics that may affect game play.
  
- 16.) The inside diameter of the insert placed into the hole in which the ball at rest shall measure at least  $\frac{1}{2}$  the diameter of the ball tossed.
  
- 17.) In addition to the provisions set forth in condition #2 of this Certification of Permissibility, no obstruction above the play field shall be closer than 3 feet to the game board.

This certification is not a license to operate the captioned gambling device. The device may only be operated in a location specifically approved for the operation of amusement games pursuant to the Law and Regulations.

The Commission reserves the right to suspend, revoke or modify this certification upon notice to the manufacturer and/or applicant.
