("Law"), and the regulations promulgated thereunder, N.J.A.C. 13:3-1.1 et seq. ("Regulations"). This approval is based upon information supplied by the applicant at the time of application for certification. The game must be operated in accordance with the specifications submitted and the terms of this certification. Any modification of the manufacturer's specifications or the specified method of play immediately voids this certification.

It is unlawful to license or operate any amusement game in the State of New Jersey without a valid Certification of Permissibility or in a manner not in accordance with Certification of Permissibility issued for the game. GAME DESCRIPTION

The Kung Fu Panda game is a single player non competitive arcade redemption game. The Kung Fu Panda game consists of a large video screen and six (6) touch pads. The said touch pads are located at the player position.

Po, the Kung Fu Panda is the animated character on the video screen. The object of the games is for the player to punch, slap and kick objects that are moving towards him. The player utilizes the touch pads in order to hit the on coming targets. The player receives points for every successful hit. If said animated character is hit by one of the moving objects the game is over. The player receives tickets based upon the final score and the posted pay out schedule. All tickets are dispensed to the player for prize redemption.

CONDITIONS

- 1.) The maximum price to play shall not exceed values set forth in N.J.A.C. 13:3-3.4.
- 2.) Payout must occur immediately in the form of tickets redeemable for prizes.
- 3.) Game shall be clean and free of debris.
- 4.) Game shall be installed and maintained according to manufacturer specifications.

The operation of the Kung Fu Panda electronic redemption game is controlled by software stored on a micro controller which is secured on the main Central Processing Unit (CPU) board.
