## GAME DESCRIPTION

Lite 'Em Up is a coin shooter redemption game. The player inserts a coin into the "shooter". When the coin gets into the shooting mechanism, it is thrown into the play field.. The player can aim the shooter in an attempt to have the coin fall into on of the eight light hole targets. If the coin falls into one of the targets, it either lights the target light or turns it off. If all of the target holes are illuminated simultaneously, a bonus is awarded. All awards are dispensed as tickets to the player for prize redemption.

## CONDITIONS


- 1.) The maximum price to play shall not exceed values set forth in N.J.A.C. 13:3-3.4.
- 2.) Payout must occur immediately upon a win.
- 3.) Game shall be clean and free of debris.
- 4.) Voltage at solenoid shall be set so that coins or tokens used can travel to any point in the play field.
- 5.) Game shall be installed and maintained according to manufacturer specifications.

This certification is not a license to operate the captioned gambling device. The device may only be operated in a location specifically approved for the operation of amusement games pursuant to the Law and Regulations.

The Commission reserves the right to suspend, revoke or modify this certification upon notice to the manufacturer and/or applicant.
