**DESCRIPTION:**

Mission Control II is a roll down game with a “Progressive Jackpot” feature. The game is played by inserting a coin or token into the coin acceptor. Once accepted, the coin or token travels down the track toward an obstacle which is a windmill-type wheel. If the coin passes through the tunnel tickets are awarded. With each successful pass of a coin into to the tunnel a letter of the word “M-I-S-S-I-O-N” is illuminated. When this is achieved the Progressive Jackpot is then awarded the value displayed on the game in addition to the basic award. The bonus values increase with each consecutive pass through the tunnel. If the coin or token falls off the track prior to reaching the tunnel, a lesser value prize is awarded. All awards are dispensed as tickets to the player for prize redemption

**CONDITIONS:**

- 1.) The maximum price to play shall not exceed values set forth in N.J.A.C. 13:3-3.4.
- 2.) Payout must occur immediately upon a win.
- 3.) Game shall be clean and free of debris.
- 4.) Game shall be installed and maintained according to manufacturer specifications.
