This approval is based upon information supplied by the applicant at the time of application for certification. The game must be operated in accordance with the specifications submitted and the terms of this certification. GAME DESCRIPTION

Popcorn is a one player redemption game. Game play starts when a blower motor begins circulating ping pong “popcorn” balls in the play field. The player moves the “Popcorn Bucket” left and right, using a handle at the front of the game, attempting to catch as many popcorn balls in the bucket within the allotted time. Tickets are awarded based upon the amount of popcorn balls that pass through (caught in) the bucket. All awards are dispensed as tickets to the player for prize redemption.


CONDITIONS

- 1.) The maximum price to play shall not exceed values set forth in N.J.A.C. 13:3-3.4.
- 2.) Payout must occur immediately upon a win.
- 3.) Game shall be clean and free of debris.
- 4.) Software EPROM ID is “BAY-TEK PC 1.08” for PIC17C756A, PLCC Checksum of E5AE.
- 5.) Game shall be installed and maintained according to manufacturer specifications.

This certification is not a license to operate the captioned gambling device. The device may only be operated in a location specifically approved for the operation of amusement games pursuant to the Law and Regulations.

The Commission reserves the right to suspend, revoke or modify this certification upon notice to the manufacturer and/or applicant.
