The above-mentioned game is approved for use in New Jersey as an amusement game, as defined in the Amusement Game Licensing Law, N.J.S.A. 5:8-100 et seq. ("Law"), and the regulations promulgated thereunder, N.J.A.C. 13:3-1.1 et seq. ("Regulations"). This approval is based upon information supplied by the applicant at the time of application for certification. The game must be operated in accordance with the specifications submitted and the terms of this certification. Any modification of the manufacturer's specifications or the specified method of play immediately voids this certification.

It is unlawful to license or operate any amusement game in the State of New Jersey without a valid Certification of Permissibility or in a manner not in accordance with Certification of Permissibility issued for the game. GAME DESCRIPTION

Raptor Captor is a one player shooting redemption game. The player launches a ball onto the play field by pressing or punching a plunger on the outside of the device. The object of the game is to shoot the ball into one of the several holes on the play field. Each hole represents a prize value. The swing arm hole in the center has prize values that rotate in sequence. If the ball passes in the swing arm hole, the player is awarded the prize that is illuminated at the time that the ball passes through the hole. Four "Jackpot" prizes are offered to the player that elects to play two or more balls. Any Jackpot attained is awarded after all balls have been played. The Jackpot is associated with five "claw" holes in the bottom of the play field. Having a ball pass through each of the five claws in one five ball round will award the highest Jackpot prize.

CONDITIONS


- 1.) The maximum price to play shall not exceed values set forth in N.J.A.C. 13:3-3.4.
- 2.) Payout must occur immediately in the form of tokens or tickets.
- 3.) Game shall be clean and free of debris.
- 4.) Game shall be installed and maintained according to manufacturer specifications.
- 5.) Software ID is "Dino2 AT4" with a MT2000 Signature of 4844 with a setting of FLASH 28F512 on "GMH 1000-0000-02: REV: F PCB 8051 VTMUX" CPU main board (on PLCC EEPROM)
