The above-mentioned game is approved for use in New Jersey as an amusement game, as defined in the Amusement Game Licensing Law, N.J.S.A. 5:8-100 et seq. ("Law"), and the regulations promulgated thereunder, N.J.A.C. 13:3-1.1 et seq. ("Regulations"). This approval is based upon information supplied by the applicant at the time of application for certification. The game must be operated in accordance with the specifications submitted and the terms of this certification. Any modification of the manufacturer's specifications or the specified method of play immediately voids this certification.

It is unlawful to license or operate any amusement game in the State of New Jersey without a valid Certification of Permissibility or in a manner not in accordance with Certification of Permissibility issued for the game. ## GAME DESCRIPTION

Ratz is a one player coin roll down redemption game. The object of the game is for a player to move a "rat" on a monitor into various parts from the "street" to the "shops" on the video play field. The player must insert a quarter into the roll down acceptor and aim for one of the 12 slots at the bottom of the play field. Each slot is representative to a section of the street or shop. Slots 1 and 12 are considered "gutter balls", and the rat will be killed off and sent back to the start. If a coin enters slots 2-11, the rat travels up the video screen in an attempt to get into a shop from the street level, or hit targets in the shop once inside. If a street target is not a door which enters a shop, tickets are dispensed based upon what is hit. Example of street targets are store windows, hot dog vendor, gum ball gum ball and news paper machines, etc. If the rat gets a door and enters, the player then rolls for larger prize values and the Jackpot bonus. The player must rolls three coins consecutively into the Jackpot holes in order to win the Jackpot. If a player rolls a coin into a hole already selected or rolls into a gutter, the bonus round ends and the player returns to the main street screen scene. Ticket values range from 2-25 for regular targets, and 10-170 for the bonus round shop values.

## CONDITIONS

- 1.) The maximum price to play shall not exceed values set forth in N.J.A.C. 13:3-3.4.
- 2.) Payout must occur immediately in the form of tokens or tickets.
- 3.) Game shall be clean and free of debris.
- 4.) Game shall be installed and maintained according to manufacturer specifications.
- 5.) Software Flash Card is "MFD032D" rats.exe with a MT2000 Signature of 0775C on EMU012-REV 1 main board

This certification is not a license to operate the captioned gambling device. The device may only be operated in a location specifically approved for the operation of amusement games pursuant to the Law and Regulations.

The Commission reserves the right to suspend, revoke or modify this certification upon notice to the manufacturer and/or applicant.
