NAME OF GAME: TAG BALLOON DART GAME

MANUFACTURER: No specific manufacturer.

APPLICANT: N/A

The game named above is hereby granted a Certification of Permissibility for operation in New Jersey pursuant to the provisions of the Amusement Games Licensing Law, N.J.S.A. 5:8-100 et seq. ("Law"), and the regulations promulgated thereunder, N.J.A.C. 13:3-1.1 et seq. ("Regulations"). This Certification of Permissibility is based upon information supplied by the applicant at the time of application for certification. The game must be operated in accordance with the Law and Regulations, the specifications submitted by the applicant and the conditions set forth in this certification. Any modification of the specifications as submitted at the time of application or the conditions set forth herein shall immediately void the Certification of Permissibility for any game so operated.

It is unlawful to license or operate any amusement game in the State of New Jersey without a valid Certification of Permissibility or in a manner not in accordance with Certification of Permissibility issued for the game.

DESCRIPTION:

A "Tag Balloon Dart Game" is a game in which a player attempts to win a prize by tossing a dart at and breaking a balloon which hides the tag bearing the designation of a prize category corresponding to the designation of a winnable prize displayed at the game. A player may also be offered the opportunity to trade up for a prize in a prize category which is displayed but not represented on the game board by a tag bearing the designation of that prize category.

DEFINITIONS:

“Game board” means the board to which the tag bearing the designation of a prize category and the target balloon which hides it are attached.

“Obstruction” means any portion of the stand/ structure, any light or other type fixture, any box, bag, prize or other material.

“Play field” shall be the area between the player position extending two (2) feet behind and two (2) feet on either side of any pedestal used for game play.

“Prize Category” means a prize, or group of prizes of comparable value, available to a player when either a target balloon is broken, revealing the designation identifying the category or a category of prize only available to a player by trading up.

“Prize category designation” means the identifier of one of the six prize categories prescribed by condition number 17 of this certification.

“Professional quality” means that the surface of the sign to be used must be smooth and rigid in nature and not made from paper or corrugated cardboard, unless laminated.

“Stand/structure” means any stand, structure, booth, tent, trailer or area in which the game is operated.

“Trade up” means trading multiple prizes of a lower prize category for a prize in a higher prize category.

“Winnable prize” means a prize in a prize category represented by a tag bearing a prize category designation hidden by an inflated target balloon on the game board.

CONDITIONS:

- 1.) The maximum price to play shall not exceed the values set forth in N.J.A.C. 13:3-3.4.
- 2.) All darts shall be maintained in a like new condition including, but not limited to, having all fins, sharp points and being balanced.
- 3.) The foul line shall be located at the rear of the counter top of stand/structure.
- 4.) The stand/structure in which the game is located shall be enclosed on three (3) sides with material sufficient to prevent anyone from traversing the area and to prevent a dart from leaving the area.

- 5.) The stand/structure shall be configured to require or allow darts to be directed towards the play field and not a player, an operator or spectator.
- 6.) The area between the foul line and the balloon targets and tags attached to the game board shall be clear of obstruction.
- 7.) At least one tag containing the designation of each of the top two winnable prize categories represented by a designation contained on a tag hidden by a target balloon shall be hidden by an inflated balloon at all times during the operation of the game.
- 8.) All prizes displayed must be available to be won either in a single round of play or by trading up through continued play.
- 9.) If a trade up system is used to award a prize of a category not represented by a designation contained on a tag hidden by a target balloon, a sign shall be conspicuously displayed posted on each such prize containing the statement "This prize is available by trade up only."
- 10.) The minimum size of a sign containing the statement required by condition number 9 of this certification shall be 4 inches x 8 inches. The sign shall be of professional quality and shall consist of block letters of at least .50 inches. The background and the letters of the sign shall be electronically displayed or permanently printed of contrasting colors.
- 11.) A game utilizing a trade up system, described in condition number 9 of this certification, shall display only two prize categories not represented on the prize board.
- 12.) A game utilizing a trade up system, described in condition number 9 of this certification, shall not offer or display a prize in more than two prize categories not represented on the game board.
- 13.) A sign explaining prize category trade up requirements shall be conspicuously posted at all times during the operation of the game.
- 14.) The minimum size of a sign containing the statement required by condition number 13 of this certification shall be 8.5 inches x 11 inches. The sign shall be of professional quality and shall consist of block letters of at least .50 inches. The background and the letters of the sign shall be electronically displayed or permanently printed of contrasting colors.
- 15.) All prizes available through the play of the game shall be conspicuously displayed above the front counter height of the stand/structure.

- 16.) The maximum number of prizes categories shall be six.
- 17.) Prize categories from lowest to highest in values shall only be known, referred to, designated, or labeled as : Small; Medium; Large; X-Large; Jumbo or Choice.
- 18.) The prizes to be awarded shall be labeled to indicate the size of the prize.
- 19.) The maximum number of prizes required in order to trade up to the next higher prize category shall be three. (IE: three small prizes are required to trade up to one medium prize.)

This certification is not a license to operate the captioned gambling device. The game must be licensed in accordance with the Law and Regulations.

The Commission reserves the right to suspend, revoke or modify this certification upon notice to the manufacturer and/or applicant.
