The above-mentioned game is approved for use in New Jersey as an amusement game, as defined in the Amusement Game Licensing Law, N.J.S.A. 5:8-100 et seq. ("Law"), and the regulations promulgated thereunder, N.J.A.C. 13:3-1.1 et seq. ("Regulations"). This approval is based upon information supplied by the applicant at the time of application for certification. The game must be operated in accordance with the specifications submitted and the terms of this certification. Any modification of the manufacturer's specifications or the specified method of play immediately voids this certification.

It is unlawful to license or operate any amusement game in the State of New Jersey without a valid Certification of Permissibility or in a manner not in accordance with Certification of Permissibility issued for the game. GAME DESCRIPTION

Titanic/Monopoly is a one to three player redemption game. The game is designed with three rows of lights that travel around the play area. The object of the game is for the player to stop the traveling light on a ticket value redeemable for prizes. There are three (3) different color rows of lights, each with a higher level of ticket value. The more coins inserted (up to three), the higher the ticket value. The player must activate a button to stop the moving light. If the light lands on the "Jackpot", the player wins the progressive jackpot value of tickets. All lights are associated with a win value, with the lights closer to the Jackpot light, the higher the ticket value. Titanic uses the luxury liner theme and Monopoly uses the board game theme. All awards are dispensed as tickets to the player for prize redemption.

CONDITIONS

- 1.) The maximum price to play shall not exceed values set forth in N.J.A.C. 13:3-3.4.
- 2.) Payout must occur immediately upon a win.
- 3.) Game shall be clean and free of debris.
- 4.) Monopoly Software EPROM ID is "NJCPU300.BIN 6BFF 6/3" for U210, MT2000
Signature of C53F, Checksum of 01456BFF.
- 5.) Game shall be installed and maintained according to manufacturer specifications.
