

**LEGALIZED GAMES OF CHANCE CONTROL COMMISSION  
PUBLIC SESSION MINUTES  
JUNE 23, 2004**

A meeting of the Legalized Games of Chance Control Commission was held on June 23, 2004 at the Office of the Division of Consumer Affairs, 124 Halsey Street, in the Morris Room, on the (6) seventh floor, Newark, New Jersey. Present for the meeting were Chairperson Marilou C. Halvorsen, Commissioners Timothy E. Ryan, Frank V. Ragazzo, Special Executive Assistant to the Director Robert Campanelli (S.E.A.D.), Executive Officer William J. Yorke (EO), Deputy Attorney General (DAG) Jodi Krugman, Regulatory Analyst (RA) Gene Brenycz, Investigators J. Michael Walker, Annette Misukonis and staff support Donna Kelly.

The meeting was opened at 10:40 a.m. by Chairperson Halvorsen pursuant to provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-1 et seq.

**GENERAL DISCUSSION**

1. Minutes of the Public Session meetings of April 21, 2004 - The Commission approved the April 21, 2004 Public Session Minutes.

2. Public Comment - Denise Putlock, Executive Director, New Jersey Amusement Association (NJAA) offered complimentary copies of "Amusement Parks of New Jersey", published by the New Jersey Amusement Association, as a reference to the Commission. Robert Campanelli, Division Ethics Officer informed Ms. Putlock that it would be an ethical conflict for the Commission to accept the books because NJAA's membership includes many of the amusement game operators licensed by the Commission.

The Commission thanked Ms. Putlock and the Association for the kind offer and directed E. O. Yorke to prepare the paperwork to purchase six of the books, one for each commissioner and one copy for use as reference by the office staff at a cost of \$19.95 each.

Yorke review all of the services provided by the Commission and all of the regulatory revisions and possible additions for possible sources of additional revenue. a) FYI-DCA-Director Erdos' Press Conference May 27, 2004, 2:00 pm - Casino Pier, Seaside Heights - E.O. Yorke stated video tapes and written remarks are available for perusal by the Commission, and a 1993 Press Conference coverage newspaper article is available for informational purposes. E.O. Yorke stated members of the Games Committee for NJAA worked to write certifications of permissibility that would insure fair and honest operation of Amusement Games in New Jersey. Ed McGlynn, Esq. and lobbyist for the NJAA stated he and E.O. Yorke have worked privately on issues related to the Amusement industry, and expressed his appreciation of E.O. Yorke working with the industry, inviting him to a NJAA board meeting. On behalf of the industry, McGlynn expressed his disappointment on how the conference turned out, feeling the Press Conference was more notoriety for the Director and Consumer Affairs, and a negative for the industry. He requested future Press Conference's take place off the boardwalk, in a midway.

b) FYI-Plaques of Appreciation for former Commissioners Alfred Peskoe and Dorothy F. McCrosson - The Commission is in full agreement of the purchase of Plaques of Appreciation for former Commissioners Alfred Peskoe and Dorothy F. McCrosson.
