

Legalized Games of Chance Control Commission
Public Session Minutes
July 09, 2008

The Legalized Games of Chance Control Commission met on July 09, 2008, at the Seaside Heights Municipal Building, located at 901 Boulevard 1st Floor Council Chamber , Seaside Heights New Jersey. Present for the meeting were Commissioners, Marilou Halvorsen Chairperson Edward Barrett, Timothy E Ryan and Christine Vanek (present via teleconference) Frank Ragazzo was not present. Also present were Deputy Attorney General Miller; LGCCC Supervisor to the Investigative Unit Scott Jenkins; LGCCC Investigators Martin Silva and supporting staff Farah Rodriguez, Danyelle Williamson

The meeting was opened at 10:35a.m. by Commissioners Marilou Halvorsen, pursuant to provisions of the Open public Meetings Act. N.J.S.A. 10:4-1 et seq. Adequate notice of the Legalized Games Public meeting was provided by mailing on March 5, 2008 in accordance with Chapter 231 P.L. 1975, more commonly referred to as the Sunshine Law. He questioned whether the items removed met the definition of the hazardous toy. Mr Jenkins advised that the Office of consumer Protection has conducted the operation and that request should be addressed to that office. Mr. Mcglnn also asked about the Commissions Investigation protocol regarding crane operation testing. Because these are open investigations staff did not comment on the protocol but thanked him for his comment.

Mr. Mcglynn, further questioned whether the Commission has made a determination whether certain video games specifically Grand Theft Auto, was obscene and therefore not a prize eligible to be awarded. Mr Jenkins noted that an operator had voluntarily removed the game when asked during an inspection and that the Commission would be considering the issue. Finally Mr. Mcglynn asked about a proposed regulation amendment regarding labeling items not available as a prizes in the field to play. The Commission's position was explained and Mr. Mcglynn noted that he would be submitting his comments in writing.
