



Legalized Games of Chance Control Commission

Public Session Minutes December 11, 2002

A meeting of the Legalized Games of Chance Control Commission was held on December 11, 2002, in the State House Annex, First Floor Committee Room 1, Trenton, New Jersey. Present for the meeting was Chairman Marylou C. Halvorsen, Commissioners Alfred Peskoe, Frank V. Ragazzo, Executive Officer William Yorke, Deputy Attorney General (DAG) Jodi Krugman, Supervisor Joseph Singh, Investigator Annette Misukonis and staff support Donna Kelly.

The meeting was opened by Chairman Halvorsen pursuant to provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-1 et seq. at 10:20 a.m.

GENERAL DISCUSSION

1. Minutes of the Public Session meeting of October 9, 2002 - The Commission approved the Public Session Minutes.

2. Public Comment - None

3. List of organizations approved or denied requests for registration for the month of October, 2002 - The Commission accepted the list of organizations approved or denied for registration for the month of October.

4. Statistics report and comparison figures from LGCCC to DCA for the month of September 2002 - The Commission approved the statistics report and comparison figures.

5. 2003 Commission Meeting Schedule - The Commission made a motion to accept the 2003 Commission Meeting schedule as presented, with the possibility of amending dates. The March 12, 2003 meeting may be rescheduled for March 19, 2003 and held at the Trump Arena in Atlantic City, coordinating with the N.J. Amusement Association Trade Show scheduled for March 19 and 20, 2003.

6. LGM-02-350 Tabtronic T-4C by TABCO Request for approval of IRT Dispensing Device - Supervising Investigator Joseph Singh stated there is a static discharge anomaly which allows for a credit to be added, which could add a ticket. However, the static level must exceed 20,000 volts. A letter from TABCO indicates that the device was

recently approved by the state of Kentucky. TABCO asks for Commission's approval based upon the state of Kentucky's allowance for the static discharge issue. The Commission determined they would approve the Pull Tab dispenser. The Commission noted they would review Kentucky's regulations, and would consider amending the regulations to address the static discharge allowance issue.

7. RQLG-02-64 Metaphysical Center of New Jersey, Inc. Request for Registration - Upon reviewing the registration application, it was not clear if this organization would be considered an educational entity. The Commission determined they would approve this request for registration.

8. RMLG-02-34 Use of Games Proceeds by VFW Post for Bldg. Fund (VFW Post #2071 Sgt. Anthony P. Grochowski I. D. # 154-7-33930) Tabled 08/14/02 mtg. - Senate Bill No. 1263: allow groups authorized to conduct bingo or raffles to use proceeds for capital improvements in certain instances. E.O. Yorke stated this Bill has passed both houses and are awaiting the Governor's signature. If the Bill is signed, the Commission will need to draft regulations which comport with the legislative amendment.

9. RMLG-02-65 VFW Post #1952 Sgt. William T. Whitaker Ladies Aux. I. D. # 271-7-27775 Request for change in method of awarding cash prizes in five week draw raffle - Based upon the current raffle regulations, the Commission is unable to approve this request. The Commission will consider changes to the regulations, and requested a draft of amendments be prepared. The Commission determined the request for a change in the method of awarding cash prizes in five week draw raffles is denied.
