S-2412

Bill S-2412 - Prohibits State departments and agencies from charging a fee to an applicant solely to correct clerical errors on any application form - Introduced December 20, 2012

Assembly Bills

A- 3618

Bill A-3618 - Requires certain disclosures in advertisements by health care professionals - Introduced December 17, 2012

A vote was taken and Cynthia Sinicropi-Philibosian voted in opposition while all others voted in favor.

A-3427

Bill A-3427 Provides for temporary professional or occupational licensure for qualified nonresident military spouses - Introduced November 19, 2012

The Board, upon a motion made by Mark J. Carangelo and seconded by Cynthia Sinicropi-Philibosian, voted to support his bills as it seems fair and reasonable.
