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I. <u>CALL TO ORDER</u>

This scheduled meeting of the Board of Marriage and Family Therapy Examiners was called to Order by Chair Ben Beitin at 10:04am, in the Warren Room 124 Halsey Street, 6th floor, Newark, New Jersey.

III. <u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES</u>

The minutes of the January 19, 2012 meeting of the Professional Counselors Committee were approved on a motion by Edward Reading, seconded by Jose Perez. Voting in favor: all.

C. <u>February 2, 2012 Professional Counselor public minutes</u>

D. January 3, 2013 Professional Counselor public minutes

The minutes of the January 3, 2013 meeting of the Professional Counselors Committee were approved on a motion by Edward Reading, seconded by Jose Perez. Voting in favor: all.

IV. <u>PUBLIC COMMENT</u>

- A. <u>**Rhoda Ondov**</u>, NJ-AMFT, Legislative Chairperson came to the meeting, but did not comment.
- **B.** <u>**Dr. Mark Woodford and Atsuko Seto**</u> from The College of New Jersey (TCNJ) submitted to the Board a list of questions regarding Marriage and Family Therapy licensure in the State of New Jersey for public discussion.

<u>QUESTION:</u> We have a three-semester sequence for practicum and internship in which students accrue supervised experience hours within a span of one and half years. Hours accrued from this training do not meet what is defined as a "part-time" in N.J.A.C.13:34-4.3a). Can individuals count these hours towards the supervised experience hours? <u>ANSWER</u>: The Board will further explore the CACREP standards that TCNJ follows regarding their definition of "part-time."

<u>QUESTION:</u> Is there any ratio of individual vs. relational hours that is required to satisfy the supervised experience of MFT? <u>ANSWER:</u> No.

<u>QUESTION:</u> According to the Three Year Temporary Permit Application, permit holdersshould complete and submit semi-annual Client Contact Supervision Hours to the Board. This particular form does not include group hours. Under which category (relational or individual) should group hours be included? <u>ANSWER:</u> The form will be updated to provide clarification.

<u>QUESTION:</u> The Board issued the proposed amendment to N.J.A.C. 13:34-4.3 on October 15, 2012. Where is the Board with the decision making process? When could individuals and training institutions expect to receive the update? <u>ANSWER:</u> October/November 2013 <u>QUESTION:</u> Would a training institution recognized by the Board need to have every intern in marriage and family therapy programs pre-approved by the Board? <u>ANSWER:</u> The Board will require all applicants to complete a supervision plan.

<u>QUESTION:</u> In the six months reports there is a section asking for a series of behaviors referring to "Developing practice related materials," a variety of forms that facilitate the practice, advertising, etc. Are these evaluation items applicable to permit holders who accrue their hours in agency settings where publicity and documentation procedures are already established?

<u>ANSWER</u>: Yes, the Board expects that any permit holder in any setting is prepared to practice independently when they apply for licensure. Even if publicity and documentation procedures are already established, permit holders should be informed of the process for creating and updating all advertising and documentation in accordance with licensing regulations.

<u>QUESTION:</u> The program curriculum for our Educational Specialist Degree (Ed.S.) in Marriage and Family Therapy has been reviewed by the Board, and several of our graduates have since obtained the credential of LMFT. We would like to confirm that our Ed.S. program is a Board recognized program.

<u>ANSWER:</u> The Board does not look much further if the degree states "Marriage and Family"

<u>QUESTION:</u> We would like clarification on the number of course(s) required to satisfy the Area I and Area II.

ANSWER: The Board will re-examine their course distribution form before replying.

<u>QUESTION:</u> Some of the students in the Department have expressed their interests in obtaining both LMFT and LPC. If individuals desire to obtain both LMFT and LPC, can they use the same supervised experience hours toward both licenses as long as individuals accrue these hours in accordance to the regulations of both licenses?

<u>ANSWER</u>: If the hours meet the requirements for both the MFT Board and the LPC Committee, then it is okay for an applicant to use the same accrued hours.

B. <u>Elise Cirelli</u>

The Board reviewed Ms. Cirelli's February 13, 2013 email regarding counseling terminally ill patients and their families over the phone. The Board determined to inquire the following: 1.) Are the clients residing in New Jersey; 2) Where is the therapy taking place; 3.) Will there be any face-to-face contact with the family perhaps; 4.) Are these established patients. There Board also determined to have Ms. Cirelli submit her job description, her supervision description, and the agency's website or brochure.
