Seton Hall University

Seton Hall University has erroneously been reported in the February 17, 2004 Regular Board Meeting Minutes as not meeting the 80% pass rate for all first time candidates from Seton Hall taking NCLEX-RN.

In fact Seton Hall University has an 80.33% pass rate for all first time candidates thereby permitting them to be returned to an accredited status.

The correction was reported at the March 6, 2004 Board of Nursing Disciplinary Meeting whereby the Board's prior motion in February was rescinded, and the Board voted to restore Seton Hall to accreditation status. This error will be mentioned again at the March 16, 2004 Regular Board Meeting.
