II. LEGISLATION

P.L.2013 Approved May 6, 2013

Requires professional boards to provide credits toward requirements for licensure for veterans with substantially equivalent training.

BILLS

ASSEMBLY BILLS

Bill A -606

This bill provides that a licensed health care professional who care for or treats a patient at a licensed health care facility (including federally qualified health care center), or a nonprofit free-standing clinic that is not owned or controlled by a licensed health care facility and does not bill for, otherwise receive any compensation for, or have any expectation to receive compensation for, the care or treatment provided.

Bill A- 1545

This bill recently signed by the Governor, revises law concerning certain professional and occupational licenses.

Bill A- 2332

This bill requires public body to publish notice of public meeting on official Internet website.

Bill A- 2344

This bill revises licensing provisions for orthotists and prosthetists and assistants. Provides an alternative pathway for individuals seeking licensure to practice orthotics or prosthetics in New Jersey, to satisfy the clinical practice requirements contained in the “Orthotist and Prosthetist Licensing Act”.

SENATE BILLS

Bill S-682

Establishes process to bar certain health care providers from receiving reimbursements under PIP

S-2727

This bill establishes “Study Commission on E-licensing”
