

The Occupational Therapy Licensing Act at N.J.S.A. 45:9-47-69, requires the education to be substantially equivalent to the program required for licensure in this State.

The Council extensively reviewed various options, and consulted with representatives of the National Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy (“NBCOT”). The Council assessed the review of applicants performed by NBCOT prior to qualifying to sit for the examination.

The Council, upon motion made by Mariann E. Moran and seconded by Aida Mendez-Boud, voted to accept the NBCOT educational credential evaluation that an educational program was comparable to meet the requirements of N.J.S.A. 45:9-47.69. Applicants will be asked to submit a letter of verification from NBCOT as part of their application.

The vote was unanimous

At 11:30 A.M. the Council, upon motion made by Tiffany Charles and seconded by Aida Mendez-Boud, voted to adjourn the meeting.
