**B. Review of the newly adopted New Jersey Uniform Prescription Blanks Program
NJPB Printing specifications N.J.A.C. 13:45A-27.1, 27.3, 27.4, 27.8 and 27.9**

Effective February 18, 2014, the Division of Consumer Affairs adopted new amendments to its Prescription Blanks Program. The goal was to increase security measures in an effort to combat blank counterfeiting by making it more difficult to do so.
