Secondly Ms. Bottiglierie discovered that a new law has been passed that goes into effect June 1, 2010 with the new capability to electronically send controlled dangerous substances as opposed to faxing which will require a physician assistant applying for “identity proofing” through an independent company and wants to know who the independent companies are.
- d. A fax from **Lynn Morgenstern, MHS, PA-C**, inquiring as to several aspects of the scope of practice.

- e. An e-mail from **Brett Liquori**, thanking the Committee for responding regarding physician assistants performing EMG. Mr. Liquori is inquiring as to whether physician assistants can perform the nerve conduction studies and wanting to know when the superior court will have an answer and why is the matter at the superior court.

On March 23, 2010, Alexander Doctoroff, D.O., on behalf of the Dermatological Society of New Jersey, requested that the State Board of Medical Examiners (the Board) amend its regulations set forth at N.J.A.C. 13:35-2B.10, 6.10 and 6.16. A notice acknowledging receipt of the petition and summarizing its contents was filed with the Office of Administrative Law and was published in the New Jersey Register on May 3, 2010 t 42 N.J.R. 859(b).
