I Legislation:

<u>A1254</u> - Requires certain civil actions against certain licensed persons to be brought within two years.

iii Education Committee

The main focus of the discussion involved the recent change of the FE and FLS examinations to computer based tests (CBT) and how this change will affect the engineering students who take the FE/FLS and subsequently file an application for an EIT/LSIT certificate through the university.
