F. CONTINUING EDUCATION

1. Update on review of Continuing Education Audit results

On a motion by Mr. Stark and seconded by Mr. Israel, the Committee voted to rescind the recommendation previously made on November 18, 2014 that licensees be penalized \$25 for each missing CEU from the licensure cycle November 1, 2011 through October 31, 2013. The fifteen licensees listed below will instead be forwarded a letter notifying them of the number of hours that they failed to complete. The licensees will be advised that they can remediate the deficiency, without penalties, if they complete all missing hours within 90 days. Licensees who fail to remediate missing hours within 90 days, however, will be subject to penalties, to include possible licensure suspension.
