A. Utilization of Professional Planner Designation While Unlicensed

a. Anthony R. Giorgio, PP - Mr. Giorgio stated on his reinstatement application that he utilized the "planner" designation on his business cards and stationary while unlicensed as a "professional planner". A uniform penalty letter was issued to him informing him that he was in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:14A-1 and N.J.S.A. 45:1-7.1. Mr. Giorgio submitted a letter of explanation for the Board's review. He signed the certification, but he did not pay the penalty amount of \$250.00.

b. Mark Lescavage, PP - Mr. Lescavage stated on his reinstatement application that he utilized the "professional planner" designation while unlicensed as a professional planner. A uniform penalty letter was issued to him informing him that he was in violation of the N.J.S.A. 45:14A-1 and N.J.S.A. 45:1-7.1.
