1. ELECTION OF OFFICERS:

2. IN THE MATTER OF THE SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION OF THE LICENSE OF **JAY V. OPRE, LMP #7336**

LICENSED TO PRACTICE AS A MASTER PLUMBER IN THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY - FILED 11-2-2011

Jay V. Opre is a licensed master plumber whose license expired on June 30, 2011, and remains expired. A consumer complaint from consumer BC alleged that the licensee was hired to install a water service to the house to convert from well to city water. Respondent failed to cover trenches that were dug and excessive rain caused those trenches to collapse resulting in damages to the consumer's property. The consumer filed a complaint in Superior Court and a default judgment was obtained for the sum of \$6,557.00. Respondent appeared for an inquiry and testified that he refuses to pay the judgment.

With respect to his business practices, Opre advised that he does not issue W-2s to workers, but provides 1099s instead. He also testified that he maintains contact with workers via cell phone and will often stamp, sign and fill out blank permits before he leaves for Florida so workers can complete them when a job arises. He also admitted that he does not keep records of contacts, and is not present for all final inspections.

Respondent is provisionally reprimanded and provisionally suspended with a \$1,500 penalty for violations of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(e) in that he engaged in professional misconduct by not paying the valid \$6,557.00 judgment obtained by consumer BC.; violation of N.J.A.C. 13:32-3.5 which provides that any plumbing work that a LMP agrees to perform shall be performed only by the LMP or the employees of the LMP; violations of N.J.A.C. 13:32-3.3(a)2, which requires only the bona fide representative, an authorized employee, or an independent contractor licensed as a master plumber, can secure all permits for plumbing work. Respondent must appear to demonstrate fitness to resume practice and satisfy all requirements for reinstatement.

3. IN THE MATTER OF THE SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION OF THE LICENSE OF **FELDMAN MIDDLETON, LMP #7026**

LICENSED TO PRACTICE AS A MASTER PLUMBER IN
THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY- FILED JANUARY 26, 2012

Respondent is reprimanded and his license is suspended for a period of one year retroactive to December 3 2009. He is fined an aggregate civil penalty totaling \$10,000 for the following violations: \$1,500 for each instance that he allowed his plumbing seal to be used to secure a plumbing permit for an unlicensed entity– totaling \$4,500, in violation of N.J.A.C. 13:32-4.1c.

Respondent is fined a civil penalty of \$1,500 for each instance of allowing plumbing work to be performed under his signed and sealed permits which was not subcontracted to another licensed contractor, nor was it performed by the respondent or the employees of the respondent– for a total of \$4,500 in violation of N.J.A.C. 13:32-3.4.

Respondent is fined a civil penalty of \$1,000 for performing plumbing work for residential project with a purchase price in excess of \$500 without obtaining a written contract in violation of N.J.A.C. 13:45a-16.2(12). Payments are scheduled within said order.

\$1,500 PENALTY AND \$1,000 CONSUMER RESTITUTION

On July 22, 2010, the Board established the licensee's failure to fully comply with NJSA 45:1-21(e) and engaged in professional misconduct when dealing with this consumer who paid for a boiler; however, the licensee failed to issue a contract or obtain a permit, inspection report or chimney certification.

A \$500 penalty is assessed for failing to indicate his license number on advertisements; \$500 for failing to obtain the necessary permit; and \$500 for failing to issue the required contract. An award of \$1,000 in consumer restitution was warranted.
