PUBLIC COMMENT:

Philip N. Sobel and Colleen Sherwood

Philip N. Sobel, President, Association of Family and Conciliation Courts (AFCC) and Colleen Sherwood attended the public meeting to discuss the organization's background, structure and mission. The organization's goal is to develop a treatment support structure with lawyers and mental health professionals working cooperatively. Mr. Sobel explained that AFCC is an international and interdisciplinary association of family, court and community professionals who share a common interest in the development and improvement of court services to couples and their children. The Board asked AFCC to provide a packet with a cover letter to include relevant articles, guidelines and position papers on the key issues, including AFCC's request for information regarding the Board's complaint review process, complaint statistics and impact on the licensees. Dr. Glat asked that the Board be advised of the next AFCC conference.

CORRESPONDENCE

Sari L. Kramer, Ph.D.

Dr. Kramer wrote requesting requesting that the Board waive the reinstatement fee for the renewal of her license. The Board voted to advise Dr. Kramer that the Board does not have the authority to waive the requirements of N.J.S.A. 45:1-7.2: "A Board may reinstate the professional or occupational license or certificate of registration or certification of an applicant whose license or certificate has been suspended pursuant to section 5 of P.L. 1999, c. 403 (C45:1-7), provided that the applicant otherwise qualifies for licensure, registration or certification and submitted the following upon application for reinstatement: payment of all past delinquent renewal fees; payment of a reinstatement fee." Voting in favor of the motion: all.

Janine Stasior, Ph.D., M.S.

Janine Stasior, Ph.D., M.S. wrote thanking the Board for their reply regarding temporary licenses for displaced psychologists.

Allyson Goldstein Elbogen, Psy.D.

Dr. Goldstein Elbogen wrote the Board requesting an extension of the 90 day limit to submit her work sample. Upon motion made and seconded, the Board voted to grant Dr. Goldstein Elbogen an additional 90 days to submit her work sample. Voting in favor of the motion: all.

Erin L. O'Hea, Ph.D.

Dr. O'Hea wrote the Board requesting approval of internship hours and post doctoral supervision hours that she completed at UMDNJ - Robert Wood Johnson Medical School without a permit prior to her licensure in the State of Pennsylvania. Upon motion made and seconded, the Board voted to approve the internship and post doctoral supervision hours accrued by Dr. O'Hea based on the fact that her file was inactive and she did not receive the notice that June 1, 2005 was the cutoff for approval of retroactive hours accrued in an exempt setting without a permit. Thomas Kay, Ph.D.

Dr. Kay wrote the Board requesting an extension to submit his work sample and clarification of the work sample requirements. Upon motion made and seconded, the Board voted to grant Dr. Kay an additional 90 days to submit the work sample. In addition, Dr. Kay will be informed that the Board does not recognize supervision alone as primary area of practice. A clinical work sample or an assessment following the guidelines is required.
