#### **PUBLIC SESSION MINUTES**

#### I. STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE WITH THE OPEN PUBLIC MEETINGS ACT

The regular meeting of the New Jersey State Board of Psychological Examiners was held at 124 Halsey Street, Newark, New Jersey in the Hudson Conference Room, 6<sup>th</sup> floor on Monday, November 2, 2015 at 9:40 A.M. Nancy E. Friedman, Ph.D., Board Chair, opened the meeting by reading the following opening statement:

# **B.** Letter from Alejandra Morales

The Board reviewed the letter from Dr. Morales requesting approval to take a ten (10) hour clinical supervision training course, to fulfill the terms of her Consent Order.

Upon motion made by Dr. Wolf-Mehlman, and seconded by Dr. Farrar-Anton, the Board voted to inform Dr. Morales that it was the Board's understanding that the NJPA course had been cancelled, and that Dr. Morales would need to submit another course for approval to fulfill the terms of the Consent Order. Voting in favor: all.

#### C. Letter from Jennifer Foster, Psy.D. TP# 123-106

The Board reviewed the letter from Dr. Foster requesting a one (1) year extension of her temporary permit, which will expire on December 6, 2015. Dr. Foster informed the Board that she was just informed she was short two hundred (200) pre-doctoral hours.

Upon motion made by Dr. Wolf-Mehlman, and seconded by Dr. Farrar-Anton, the Board voted to approve Dr. Foster for a one (1) year extension, so that she may complete the hours and all other licensure requirements. Dr. Foster's permit will now expire on December 6, 2016. Voting in favor: all.

#### VIII. REPORT ON PERMIT CONFERENCES

## A. Ivan Lamourt, Psy.D./ Gerald Figurelli, Ph.D.

Dr. Lamourt appeared before a Committee of the Board to discuss his plans for retaking the E.P.P.P. Dr. Lamourt's permit expires on May 13, 2016.

Upon motion made by Dr. Farrar-Anton, and seconded by Dr. Groveman, the Board voted to approve Dr. Lamourt's plan for retaking the E.P.P.P. with no changes to current case load, and the Board expects Dr. Lamourt to complete all licensure requirements by May 13, 2016, when his permit expires. The Board voted to inform Dr. Lamourt that he will only be granted a further extension if there are extenuating circumstances, and that without a permit, he cannot work with private clients. Voting in favor: all.

#### B. Vonetta Kalieta, Ph.D. / Alan Cavaiola, Ph.D.

Dr. Kalieta appeared before a Committee of the Board to discuss her plans for retaking the E.P.P.P. Dr. Kalieta is currently working in an exempt setting and does not need a permit to work in her current setting.

Upon motion made by Dr. Farrar-Anton, and seconded by Dr. Evers, the Board voted that because Dr. Kalieta is no longer under permit, she would not need another permit conference, and cannot work in an exempt setting. Voting in favor:all.

#### C. Michael Panella, Ph.D./ Raymond Hanbury, Ph.D.

Dr. Panella appeared before a Committee of the Board to discuss his plans for retaking the E.P.P.P. Dr. Panella plans on retaking the exam in January.

Upon motion made by Dr. Wolf-Mehlman, and seconded by Dr. Evers, the Board voted to approve Dr. Pannella's plan for retaking the E.P.P.P. Dr. Panella's permit will be extended for six (6) months from today's meeting, with no further extensions granted, and will now expire on May 2, 2016. Voting in favor: all.

#### D. Ayanna Towers, Psy.D./ Patrick Connelly, Psy.D.

Dr. Towers was scheduled to appear for a permit conference and did not appear.

#### E. Cara Church, Psy.D./ Allen Blasucci, Psy.D.

Dr. Church appeared before a Committee of the Board to discuss her plans for retaking the E.P.P.P. Dr. Church plans on retaking the exam as soon as possible. Dr. Church works for Easter Seals, which is not an exempt setting. Dr. Church's permit expires on April 1, 2016. Upon motion made by Dr. Brickfield, and seconded by Dr. Wolf-Mehlman, the Board voted to inform Dr. Church that Easter Seals is not an exempt setting, and that she can not work there without supervision. Dr. Church must provide a letter from her supervisor indicating he agrees to supervise her work at Easter Seals. Voting in favor: all.
