Upon motion made by Dr. Brickfield and seconded by Dr. Watter, the Board voted to approve the public session minutes of April 4, 2011, with corrections. Voting in favor of the motion: all.

CORRESPONDENCE

Jon Lyman, Psy.D., TP #083-923

Dr. Lyman wrote requesting an extension of his three-year supervised temporary permit beyond the July 29, 2011 expiration date.

Dr. Lyman stated that he has not accrued the required number of post-doctoral hours to be eligible to take the E.P.P.P. written examination.

Upon motion made Dr. Watter and seconded by Dr. Roy, the Board voted to extend Dr. Lyman's temporary permit for an additional year. Dr. Lyman will be advised that his permit will now expire on July 29, 2012. Voting in favor of the motion: all.

Steven Hertler, Psy.D., TP #083-921

Dr. Hertler wrote requesting an extension of his three-year supervised temporary permit beyond the July 28, 2011 expiration date.

Dr. Hertler stated that he has not accrued the required number of post-doctoral hours to be eligible to take the E.P.P.P. written examination. Dr. Hertler further stated that due to changes in his personal life, he can now devote sufficient time to completing his supervision hours and studying for the written examination.

the required work sample for the oral examination.

Upon motion made by Dr. Watter and seconded by Dr. Roy, the Board voted to schedule Dr. Fischer for a conference to discuss his repeated requests for extension of time to submit his work sample. Voting in favor of the motion: all.

Danielle McCarthy, Ph.D., TP #083-919

Dr. McCarthy wrote requesting an extension of her three-year supervised temporary permit beyond the July 17, 2011 expiration date.

Dr. McCarthy stated that she has not accrued the required number of post-doctoral hours to be eligible to take the E.P.P.P. written examination. Dr. McCarthy further stated that because of other duties as an assistant professor, she could accrue additional hours of supervision.

Upon motion made by Dr. Watter and seconded by Dr. Roy, the Board voted to extend Dr. McCarthy's temporary permit for an additional year. Dr. McCarthy will be advised that her permit will now expire on July 17, 2012. Voting in favor of the motion: all.

Laura Berness, Ph.D., TP #073-809

Dr. Berness wrote requesting an extension of her three-year supervised temporary permit beyond the July 27, 2011 expiration date.

Dr. Berness stated that she has not accrued the required year of post-doctoral hours to be eligible to take the E.P.P.P. written examination. Dr. Berness further stated that she can only conduct clinical work on a part-time basis because she is also employed full time as an assistant professor.

Upon motion made by Dr. Watter and seconded by Dr. Roy, the Board voted to extend Dr. Berness's temporary permit for an additional year. Dr. Berness will be advised that her permit will now expire on July 27, 2012. Voting in favor of the motion: all.

Sharese Dawes, Ph.D., TP #063-700

Dr. Dawes wrote requesting that her three-year supervised temporary permit be reissued so that she may continue to accrue her post-doctoral supervision hours.

Dr. Dawes stated that she was not able to finish the process with the previous temporary permit issued on June 14, 2006 because of family obligations that have interfered with her professional career. Her situation has now changed and she is now able to continue with her professional career.

Upon motion made by Dr. Watter and seconded by Dr. Roy, the Board voted to approve the re-issue of a three-year supervised permit for a period of one year. Dr. Dawes will be advised that she needs to submit the required paperwork and fee for the issuance of the temporary permit. Voting in favor of the motion: all.

Dr. Lamana-Adone failed the E.P.P.P. written examination administered on May 6, 2011 and is currently working under a three-year supervised temporary permit.

Upon motion made by Dr. Roy and seconded by Dr. Watter, the Board voted to continue Dr. Lamana-Adone's temporary permit with no changes or reduction in caseload. Dr. Lamana-Adone's temporary permit will expire on August 10, 2013. Dr. Lamana-Adone will be advised that she can obtain a Feedback by Role report for this administration of the written examination if she wishes. Voting in favor of the motion: all.

Dr. Matthaei failed the E.P.P.P. written examination administered on April 26, 2011 and is currently working under a three-year temporary permit.

Upon motion made by Dr. Brickfield and seconded by Dr. Roy, the Board voted to extend Dr. Matthaei's temporary permit for an additional year with no changes or reduction in caseload. Dr. Matthaei will be advised that her temporary permit will now expire on November 17, 2012. Upon motion made by Dr. Roy and seconded by Dr. Watter, the Board voted to approve the PBI Professinal Boundaries Course/Mental Health Professional Edition. However, the Board denied her request to approve Dr. Feder as her therapist. The Board feels that in this case, a therapist with the same theoretical orientation as Dr. Klein- von Reiche would be more appropriate. The Board suggested that she contact either Milton Spett, Ph.D. or Lynn Mollick, Ph.D. Voting in favor of the motion: all.
