Take notice that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-5.1, the rules at N.J.A.C. 13:40 were scheduled to expire on July 12, 2018. These rules address such items as the application process and requirements for engineers-in-training, land surveyors-in-training, professional engineers and professional land surveyors, and home inspectors; the processes for licensure renewal, reactivation, and reinstatement, as well as licensure by comity; continuing education requirements; standards of practices; the preparation of land surveys; the required

tools and equipment for home inspections; and the requirements of a pre-home inspection agreement.

The State Board of Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors is developing rulemaking to revise and update existing N.J.A.C. 13:40, and anticipates filing this rulemaking with the Office of Administrative Law for processing in the ordinary course. However, this rulemaking could not be proposed prior to the expiration of existing N.J.A.C. 13:40. The Board has reviewed N.J.A.C. 13:40 and determined that, pending the finalization of the anticipated rulemaking described above, the existing chapter remains necessary, proper, reasonable, efficient, understandable, and responsive for the purposes for which it was originally promulgated, as amended and supplemented over time, and pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-5.1.c(1), this chapter is readopted and shall continue in effect for a seven-year period.
