THIS MATTER was opened to the Board of Chiropractic Examiners (the "Board") with a Verified Complaint filed by the Attorney General of New Jersey on June 16, 2008. The Respondent Bryan Bajakian, D.C. denies the substantive allegations of the Complaint.

The Board previously entered an Interim Consent Order in this case on September 15, 2005.

The Verified Complaint sought, among other things, the temporary suspension of the Respondent's license to practice

chiropractic in the State of New Jersey. The Respondent wishes to avoid further proceedings regarding the Attorney General's application for a temporary suspension of the Respondent's license. The Board has determined that the within disposition is adequate to protect the public health, safety and welfare at this time. The Respondent consents and agrees to each and every term of this Interim Consent Order. For such reasons and other good cause shown,

IT IS on this 26th day of June, 2008,

ORDERED:

1. The license issued to the Respondent Bryan Bajakian, D.C. is hereby temporarily suspended, and the Respondent shall immediately cease and desist from the practice of chiropractic in the State of New Jersey and from providing any health care services of any nature whatsoever to any person within the State of New Jersey, pending a plenary hearing in this matter or until further Order of the Board.

2. The Respondent Bryan Bajakian, D.C. shall immediately cease and desist from holding himself out to the public as a person authorized to practice chiropractic in the State of New Jersey. The Respondent Bryan Bajakian, D.C. shall take prompt action to remove or cancel all advertisements of any nature whatsoever, including websites and internet postings, by which the Respondent offers to provide services as a chiropractor. The Respondent shall

specifically terminate the website "chiropractic4all.com." The Respondent shall also take prompt action to disconnect any telephone number or email address that is associated with the Respondent's practice of chiropractic, including the telephone numbers ~~(201) 575-2251~~^{BKS} and (973) 962-6313. The Respondent shall promptly remove any signs or postings from any location whatsoever that identify Respondent as a chiropractor or by which the Respondent offers to provide services as a chiropractor.

3. Nothing in this Interim Consent Order shall be deemed an admission of any fact or expert opinion regarding this matter by any of the Respondent, the Attorney General or the Board.

4. Nothing in this Interim Consent Order shall limit in any way the right and prerogative of the Board, the Attorney General or any other regulatory or law enforcement entity to conduct or to continue any investigation of, or to prosecute any action against, the Respondent.


5. This Interim Consent Order is not a final disposition of this matter, and the Respondent expressly agrees and acknowledges the action commenced by the Attorney General's Verified Complaint shall proceed in the usual course.

6. This matter shall be transferred to the Office of Administrative Law for the plenary. The Board, however, shall not transfer this matter until the final resolution of the pending criminal charges brought against the Respondent.

7. The Interim Consent Order of September 15, 2005, is hereby vacated in its entirety.


