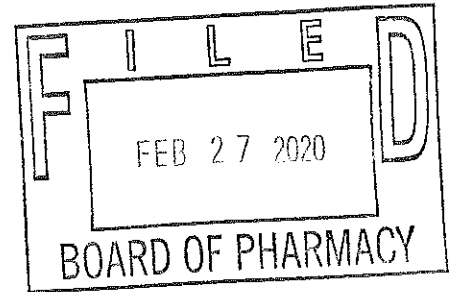

Administrative Action

INTERIM CONSENT ORDER

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy (the "Board") upon receipt of information that Anny Chan, R.Ph., License No. 28RI02371000 ("Respondent") has resigned from her position as the Registered Pharmacist in Charge of Panther Valley Pharmacy located at Rt. 517, Village Square Mall, Allamuchy, New Jersey. Respondent's resignation followed the initiation of an investigation by the Board pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-1 et. seq. which is ongoing.

It appearing that Respondent agrees to voluntarily enter into an interim agreement surrendering her license to practice pharmacy, to be deemed a temporary suspension, without making admissions and without prejudice to her ability to defend any action brought based on the

pending investigation, and the Board finding the within disposition adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare, and for good cause shown;

IT IS THEREFORE ON THIS 27th day of February, 2020,

ORDERED AND AGREED:

1. Respondent is granted leave to and shall immediately surrender her license to practice pharmacy in the State of New Jersey pending disposition of the Board's ongoing investigation against her and further order of the Board. Said surrender shall be deemed a temporary suspension of Respondent's license to practice pharmacy.

2. Respondent shall immediately cease and desist from engaging in the practice of pharmacy, which includes, but is not limited to the following: Respondent shall not handle, order, inventory, compound, count, fill, refill or dispense any drug; she shall not handle anything requiring a prescription, including devices and medications; she shall not handle prescriptions; she shall not advise or consult with patients, and she is prohibited from being present within a prescription filling area of a pharmacy.

3. Respondent shall surrender her original wall certificate, wallet certificate, and the most recent renewal card of her license to the Executive Director of the Board immediately upon the entry of this Order by mailing same to Anthony Rubinaccio, Executive Director, Board of Pharmacy, P.O. Box 45013, Newark, New Jersey 07101.


4. Nothing contained herein shall be deemed an admission of liability on the part of the Respondent, nor prejudice her ability to defend any charges against her resulting from the Board's ongoing investigation.

5. Any practice in this State in violation of the above conditions shall constitute unlicensed practice and/or grounds for discipline for violation of a Board Order and professional misconduct.

6. The Board reserves the right to place restrictions and/or limitations upon Respondent's license to practice as a pharmacist in the State of New Jersey in the event that her license is reinstated.


7. The entry of the within Order is without prejudice to the further investigation, prosecution and/or initiation of disciplinary action based upon any violations by Respondent of any statutes or regulations governing the practice of pharmacy in the State or any violations of law, by the Board, the Attorney General or any other regulatory or law enforcement agency, including but not limited to any pending matters under investigation.


