

**CONSENT ORDER OF
VOLUNTARY SURRENDER
OF CERTIFICATION**

TO PRACTICE AS A HOMEMAKER –
HOME HEALTH AIDE THE STATE OF
NEW JERSEY

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Nursing (the "Board") upon receipt of information that, on or about March 6, 2019, Emma Llanes ("Respondent") was criminally charged with engaging in conduct which created a substantial risk of bodily injury to her patient, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:24-7.1a (1). It was alleged that, while caring for a 90-year old bedridden patient, Respondent engaged in conduct that raised the strong possibility that her patient could have sustained physical injury. On December 5, 2019, Respondent pled guilty to the charge and was given a conditional dismissal for one year.

A video recording of Respondent's interactions with the patient, reveals, among other things, Respondent put a cloth over the patient's face without reason, handled the patient roughly, grabbed the patient by the back of the neck and pushed the patient's head forward, slapped the patient's legs and failed to assist the patient while getting dressed.

Respondent wishing to voluntarily enter into this agreement and waiving any right to a hearing, and the Board finding the within disposition adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare, and other good cause having been shown;

IT IS THEREFORE ON THIS 21st day of May, 2020,

ORDERED:

1. Respondent voluntarily agrees to surrender her certification, to be deemed a permanent revocation of her certification. Respondent shall not apply for reinstatement of her certification in New Jersey.

2. Respondent shall immediately cease and desist from representing herself as a certified homemaker-home health aide and engaging in practice as a certified homemaker-home health aide. Any such representation or practice by Respondent constitutes grounds for a charge of unlicensed practice pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-25.




