Take notice that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-5.1, the rules at N.J.A.C. 13:47C were scheduled to expire on April 21, 2017. These rules address the methods of sale for foodstuffs, including meat, poultry and shellfish, and nonfoodstuffs, such as firewood and cordwood. This includes rules on selling items by net weight, count, or measure. These rules also address the surety bond requirements for certain buyers of precious metals and the process customers are to follow if they have a claim against such buyers.

The Office of Weights and Measures has reviewed the rules and has determined them to be necessary, reasonable, and proper for the purpose for which they were originally promulgated, as required by Executive Order No. 66 (1978). Therefore, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-5.1, these rules are readopted and shall continue in effect for a seven-year period.
