**Take notice** that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-5.1, the rules at N.J.A.C. 13:45C were scheduled to expire on March 25, 2018. The rules concern uniform regulations applicable to licensees, permittees, certificate holders, and registrants of the *Division of Consumer Affairs* (the Division), any professional and occupational licensing board or committee located within the Division, and the Legalized Games of Chance Control Commission.

Subchapter 1 outlines the rules applicable to licensees' duty to cooperate and to comply with board orders. Subchapter 2 establishes standards for requests for waivers from regulatory requirements. [page=4014] Subchapter 3 contains rules concerning the use of performance-based outcomes assessments when resolving alleged violations.

The New Jersey ***Division of Consumer Affairs*** has reviewed the rules and has determined them to be necessary, reasonable, and proper for the purpose for which they were originally promulgated, as required by Executive Order No. 66 (1978). Therefore, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:8-30.2, 45:1-17(b), and 52:17B-122, and in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14B-5.1.c(1), these rules are readopted and shall continue in effect for a seven-year period.
