**Notice of Continuing Education Topics**

Take notice that the State Board of Examiners of Heating, Ventilating, Air Conditioning, and Refrigeration Contractors (Board) has determined the topics that shall be part of continuing education courses taken by licensed master heating, ventilating, air conditioning, and refrigeration contractors (master HVACR contractors) during the 2016 through 2018 biennial renewal period. N.J.A.C. 13:32A-4.1 requires licensed master HVACR contractors to complete five credits of continuing education every biennial renewal period. N.J.A.C. 13:32A-4.3 requires that one hour of continuing education be in statutes and rules governing the practice of heating, ventilating, air conditioning, and refrigeration and that one hour be in propane services. N.J.A.C. 13:32A-4.3 requires the Board to determine the topics required for the remaining three hours. The Board has determined that these three hours shall be devoted to any topic relevant to the practice of heating, ventilating, air conditioning, and refrigeration as defined by N.J.A.C. 13:32A-1.2. This notice is published pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:32A-4.3.
