**Take notice** that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-5.1, the rules at N.J.A.C. 13:33 were scheduled to expire on February 1, 2018. The rules establish standards for the licensing and regulation of ophthalmic dispensers and ophthalmic technicians. Subchapter 1 outlines standards for apprentices. Subchapter 2 outlines the licensing procedure. Subchapter 3 deals with professional practices. Subchapter 4 addresses the dispensing of contact lenses. Subchapter 5 contains rules of practice. Subchapter 6 requires licensees to complete continuing education. Subchapter 7 establishes requirements for advertising. Subchapter 8 sets forth license renewal requirements, Board notification requirements, sexual misconduct prohibitions, and the fees that are charged by the Board.

The State Board of Examiners of Ophthalmic Dispensers and Ophthalmic Technicians has reviewed the rules and has determined them to be necessary, reasonable, and proper for the purpose for which they were originally promulgated, as required by Executive Order No. 66 (1978). Therefore, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14B-5.1.c(1), these rules are readopted without amendments and shall continue in effect for a seven-year period.
