Rules of the Occupational Therapy Advisory Council

Take notice that, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-5.1, the rules at N.J.A.C. 13:44K will expire on March 31, 2016. The rules establish standards for the licensing and regulation of occupational therapists and occupational therapy assistants, including temporary licensure, scope of practice, supervision of occupational therapy assistants, general obligations of licensees, business practices, professional conduct, client records, and fees.

The **Division of Consumer Affairs**, in consultation with the Occupational Therapy Advisory Council, has reviewed the rules and has determined them to be necessary, reasonable, and proper for the purpose for which they were originally promulgated, as required by Executive Order No. 66 (1978). Therefore, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-15 and 45:9-37.51, and in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14B-5.1.c(1), these rules are readopted and shall continue in effect for a seven-year period.
