Notice of Public Hearing

Unit Pricing Rules

Take notice that the Division of Consumer Affairs (Division) intends to receive public comments regarding amendments to the Unit Pricing rules at N.J.A.C. 13:45A-14. The Division wishes to solicit public input specifically on simplifying the manner in which unit prices are calculated based on approved units of measure, and modifying the list of commodities and classes of retail establishments exempt from the rules.

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 56:8-24, the Director of the Division is required to conduct a public hearing whenever it considers revising the manner in which price per measure shall be calculated and displayed, and modifying the list of commodities and classes of retail establishments exempt from the rules. The public hearing on this matter will be held on Thursday, August 19, 2021, beginning at 10:00 AM and will be conducted virtually through the Division's video conferencing software.

Those interested in speaking at the public hearing must register with the Division. Requests to speak at the public hearing must be submitted no later than one week prior to the hearing date. Individuals unable to speak at the hearing may provide written statements to the Division for consideration.
