**Take notice** that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-5.1, the rules at N.J.A.C. 13:42A were scheduled to expire on July 2, 2019. The rules establish standards for the certification and regulation of State-certified psychoanalysts. Subchapter 1 contains definitions for terms used in N.J.A.C. 13:42A, rules on the use of the title "State-certified psychoanalyst," and fees charged for services provided by the Committee. Subchapter 2 sets forth qualification standards for certification. Subchapter 3 establishes standards for certification examinations and Subchapter 4 sets forth continuing education

requirements for State-certified psychoanalysts. Subchapter 5 deals with renewal of certification. Subchapter 6 addresses patient record requirements and Subchapter 7 sets forth practice standards for State-certified psychoanalysts.

The Director has reviewed the rules and has determined them to be necessary, reasonable, and proper for the purpose for which they were originally promulgated, as required by Executive Order No. 66 (1978). Therefore, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14B-5.1c(1), these rules are readopted and shall continue in effect for a seven-year period.

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
