Rules of the Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners

Take notice that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-5.1, the rules at N.J.A.C. 13:44 were scheduled to expire on December 14, 2017. The rules at N.J.A.C. 13:44 establish standards for the licensing and regulation of veterinarians. Subchapter 1 outlines the licensing procedure. Subchapter 2 deals with temporary permits, which allow unlicensed qualified veterinary graduates to work as assistants to licensees. Subchapter 3 provides definitions relevant to the practice of veterinary medicine, such as "animal or veterinary facility," "person," "practice of veterinary medicine, surgery or dentistry" and "qualified veterinary graduate." Subchapter 4 contains rules of practice. Subchapter 5 sets forth the fees that are charged by the Board.

The Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners has reviewed the rules and has determined them to be necessary, reasonable, and proper for the purpose for which they were originally promulgated, as required by Executive Order No. 66 (1978). Therefore, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:16-3, [page=3546] and in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14B-5.1.c(1), these rules are readopted and shall continue in effect for a seven-year period.
