ASSEMBLY BILL NO. A2181

13. Board to discuss Assembly Bill No. A2181 which revises the qualifications for an electrical contractor's license. In order to qualify, an individual must have been employed or engaged in the business of electrical construction and installation for a period of five years.

Four of those five years must be spent in an electrical apprenticeship program accredited and approved by the United States Department of Labor while actually employed or engaged as an electrical apprentice, and one of the five years must be spent as a journeyman electrician.

14. Executive Director's Report

E-mail received from an applicant who took the electrical contractors examination on March 19, 2019. The applicant stated she feels the examination was not conducted fairly as she was not provided with a tabbed National Electrical Code Book while other applicants did receive a tabbed book. The applicant also states the book she was provided with had pencil markings throughout. The applicant further states some of the questions did not have an appropriate answer.
