Amusement Game Certification of Permissibility Number, 1-144 Bottle Flip

The above-mentioned game is approved for use in New Jersey as an amusement game, as defined in the Amusement Game Licensing Law, N.J.S.A. 5:8-100 et seq. ("Law"), and the regulations promulgated thereunder, N.J.A.C. 13:3-1.1 et seq. ("Regulations"). This approval is based upon information supplied by the applicant at the time of application for certification. The game must be operated in accordance with the specifications submitted and the terms of this certification. Any modification of the manufacturer's specifications or the specified method of play immediately voids this certification.

It is unlawful to license or operate any amusement game in the State of New Jersey without a valid Certification of Permissibility or in a manner not in accordance with Certification of Permissibility issued for the game. This Certification of Permissibility contains four pages. This is page 1 of 5.

DESCRIPTION:

The Bottle Flip game is a single player non-competitive skill redemption game. The Bottle Flip game consists of a level "Game board" with various sized colors and various sizes. Each color depicts a 'Prize Category' which is in accordance with the amusement game regulations (Small, Medium, Large, Extra Large, Jumbo or Choice).

The object of the game is for the player to flip a clear 16.9 fluid ounce plastic bottle filled with 4 ounces of water, 360 degrees into the air in an attempt to land the bottle on the level "Game board" which consists of various prize levels. If the clear plastic bottle falls off the "Game board" or does not land standing up right then the game is deemed over. If the player does successfully land the clear plastic bottle up right, the player is immediately awarded a prize based upon the posted prize schedule.

DEFINITIONS:

"Game board" means the area which the clear plastic bottle must land up right and come to rest.

"Obstruction" means any portion of the stand/structure, any light or other type fixture, any box, bag, prize or other material.

"Play field" shall be the area between the player position extending two (2) feet behind and one (1) foot on either side.

"Prize Category" means a prize, or group of prizes of comparable value, available to a player upon completion of the task necessary to win a prize in a particular category or available to a player by "trade up. "

"Prize Category designation" means the identifier of one of the six authorized "Prize Categories" prescribed by condition 10 of this Certification of Permissibility.

"Professional quality" means that the surface of the sign to be used must be smooth and rigid in nature and not made from paper or corrugated cardboard, unless laminated.

"Round of play" means the sale of a right to participate, the event which determines whether the player wins or loses and the awarding of a prize.

"Stand/structure" means any stand, structure, booth, tent, trailer or area in which the game is operated.

"Trade up" means trading multiple prizes of a lower prize category for a prize in a higher prize category.

CONDITIONS:

- 1.) The maximum posted price to play shall not exceed values set forth in N.J.A.C. 13:3-.3.4.
- 2.) The "Game board" and "Play field" shall be clear of all "Obstructions".
- 3.) The "Play field" shall be contained within the stand/structure in which the game is located.
- 4.) No merchandise shall be allowed in or around the stand/structure for display purposes unless a posted sign which clearly indicates for display only.
- 5.) All prizes displayed must be available to be won either in a single "Round of play" or by "Trade up" through continued play.
- 6.) A "Professional quality" sign explaining prize category trade up requirements shall be conspicuously posted at all times during the operation of the game.
- 7.) The minimum size of a "Professional quality" sign containing the statement required by condition number 6 of this certification shall be 8.5 inches x 11 inches. The sign shall be of professional quality and shall consist of block letters of at least .50 inches. The background and the letters of the sign shall be electronically displayed or permanently printed of contrasting colors.
- 8.) All prizes available through the play of the game shall be conspicuously displayed above the front counter height of the stand/structure.
- 9.) The maximum number of "Prize Categories" shall not exceed six (6).
- 10.) "Prize Category" from the lowest to highest in values shall only be known, referred to, designated, or labeled as: Small; Medium; Large; XL, Jumbo or Choice.
- 11.) The prizes to be awarded shall be labeled to indicate the category. Prizes shall be labeled individually or as a clearly delineated group of the same "Prize Category".
- 12.) The maximum number of prizes required in order to "Trade up" to the next higher "Prize Categories" shall be three (3). (IE: Three Small prizes are required to "Trade up" to one Medium prize. Three Medium prizes are required to "Trade up" to one Large prize. Three Large prizes are required to "Trade up" to one XL prize and three XL prizes are required to "Trade up" to a Jumbo prize and three Jumbo prizes are required to "Trade up" to a Choice prize).

- 13.) The requirements for the plastic bottle must be a clear 16.9 fluid ounce bottle filled with exactly four (4) fluid ounces of water and properly sealed.
- 14.) The clear plastic bottle is required to be clearly marked with a permanent marking at the four (4) fluid ounce level.
- 15.) The clear plastic bottle is required to be maintained in like new condition with flat undented bottoms and sides.
- 16.) If any game used clear plastic bottle does not meet the criteria's in conditions #13, #14 and # 15 of this certification then the bottle must be removed immediately from game play.
- 17.) The player is required to flip the bottle a minimum of 360 degrees in the air. If the player successfully lands the bottle up right on the "Game board" the player is immediately awarded a prize based upon the posted prize schedule.
- 18.) The "Game board" shall be a flat level surface with a maximum height of thirty-six (36) inches in height measured from the floor where the player stands.
- 19.) The maximum distance from the player's position to the "Game board" shall not exceed forty-eight (48) inches. This distance is measured from the player's foot position to the front of the "Game board".
- 20.) The "Game board" shall have a minimum width of eighteen (18) inches and a minimum length of twenty-four (24) inches.
- 21.) The minimum color section to delineate a prize shall have a measurement of no less than six (6) inches in length.
- 22.) The color marking on the "Game board" to determine the player's prize must be clearly marked with a permanent color which is clearly delineated from the next color "Prize Category".
- 23.) Foul zones are not permitted for this game.

This Certification of Permissibility is not a license to operate the captioned gambling device. The game must be licensed in accordance with the Law and Regulations.

The Commission reserves the right to suspend, revoke or modify this Certification of Permissibility upon notice to the manufacturer, operator and/or applicant.
