The above-mentioned game is approved for use in New Jersey as an amusement game, as defined in the Amusement Game Licensing Law, N.J.S.A. 5:8-100 et seq. ("Law"), and the regulations promulgated thereunder, N.J.A.C. 13:3-1.1 et seq. ("Regulations"). This approval is based upon information supplied by the applicant at the time of application for certification. The game must be operated in accordance with the specifications submitted and the terms of this certification. Any modification of the manufacturer's specifications or the specified method of play immediately voids this certification.

It is unlawful to license or operate any amusement game in the State of New Jersey without a valid Certification of Permissibility or in a manner not in accordance with Certification of Permissibility issued for the game. This Certification of Permissibility contains four pages. This is page 1 of 4.

DESCRIPTION:

The Slingshot Game is a single player non competitive skill redemption game. The games play field consists of a slingshot that is secured at the player position, and several targets with openings and a net attached to a revolving turntable.

The object of the game is for the player to shoot the rag ball through one of the twenty (20) plus game targets' openings. Once this is achieved, the player is awarded a prize according to the posted prize schedule.

DEFINITIONS:

“Game board” means the target opening that the rag ball passes through.

“Obstruction” means any portion of the stand/structure, any light or other type fixture, any box, bag, prize or other material.

“Play field” shall be the area between the player position extending two (2) feet behind and one (1) foot on either side.

“Prize Category” means a prize, or group of prizes of comparable value, available to a player upon completion of the task necessary to win a prize in a particular category or available to a player by “trade up. ”

“Prize category designation” means the identifier of one of the six authorized prize categories prescribed by condition 10 of this Certification of Permissibility.

“Professional quality” means that the surface of the sign to be used must be smooth and rigid in nature and not made from paper or corrugated cardboard, unless laminated.

“Round of play” means the sale of a right to participate, the event which determines whether the player wins or loses and the awarding of a prize.

“Stand/structure” means any stand, structure, booth, tent, trailer or area in which the game is operated.

“Trade up” means trading multiple prizes of a lower prize category for a prize in a higher prize category.

CONDITIONS:

- 1.) The maximum posted price to play shall not exceed values set forth in **N.J.A.C.** 13:3-.3.4.
- 2.) The play field shall be clear of all obstructions.
- 3.) The play field shall be contained within the stand/structure in which the game is located.
- 4.) No merchandise shall be allowed in or around the stand/structure for display purposes unless a posted sign which clearly indicates for display only.
- 5.) All prizes displayed must be available to be won either in a single round of play or by trading up through continued play.
- 6.) A sign explaining prize category trade up requirements shall be conspicuously posted at all times during the operation of the game.
- 7.) The minimum size of a sign containing the statement required by condition number 6 of this certification shall be 8.5 inches x 11 inches. The sign shall be of professional quality and shall consist of block letters of at least .50 inches. The background and the letters of the sign shall be electronically displayed or permanently printed of contrasting colors.
- 8.) All prizes available through the play of the game shall be conspicuously displayed above the front counter height of the stand/structure.
- 9.) The maximum number of prize categories shall not exceed four (4).
- 10.) Prize categories from the lowest to highest in values shall only be known, referred to, designated, or labeled as: Small; Medium; Large; Jumbo/Choice.
- 11.) The prizes to be awarded shall be labeled to indicate the category. Prizes shall be labeled individually or as a clearly delineated group of the same prize category.
- 12.) The maximum number of prizes required in order to trade up to the next higher prize category shall be three (3). (IE: Three Small prizes are required to trade up to one Medium prize. Three Medium prizes are required to trade up to one Large prize. Three Large prizes are required to trade up to one Jumbo/Choice prize.
- 13.) The rag ball used for the game measures nine (9) inches in diameter and is manufactured by Sportstime Inc. No substitutions.
- 14.) Each rag ball utilized during game play shall be in accordance with manufacturer specifications and shall be of equal in size, shape, weight, and all other characteristics that may affect game play.
- 15.) Each slingshot shall be secured to the front counter of the stand/structure in a manner that will prevent its removal and that will only allow the rag ball to be pointed and shot in the direction of the game target.

- 16.) The slingshot which is secured to the stand/structure shall be level with the carousel platform where the game targets are located.
- 17.) Each game target "pigs heads" shall have an opening no less than a six (6) inches measure from top to bottom and six (6) inches measured from left to right. *(The game target figures maybe subject to modification whether by size, shape or theme only with the approval by the Legalized Games of Chance Control Commission.)*
- 18.) The maximum distance from the play position/ slingshot shall not exceed seventeen (17) feet.
- 19.) The maximum distance the player can stretch the slingshot's rubber band is twenty-seven (27) inches. Attached to the slingshot is a stainless steel cable on each side of the rubber band to assure this distance. This cables also keep players from over extended the rubber band which may cause it to break.

This Certification of Permissibility is not a license to operate the captioned gambling device. The game must be licensed in accordance with the Law and Regulations.

The Commission reserves the right to suspend, revoke or modify this Certification of Permissibility upon notice to the manufacturer, operator and/or applicant.
