Certification of Permissibility Number 4-006**

NAME OF GAME: Skilo
MANUFACTURER: Unknown
APPLICANT: Control Commission Records

The game named above is hereby granted a Certification of Permissibility for operation in New Jersey pursuant to the provisions of the Amusement Games Licensing Law, N.J.S.A. 5:8-100 et seq. ("Law"), and the regulations promulgated thereunder, N.J.A.C. 13:3-1.1 et seq. ("Regulations"). This Certification of Permissibility is based upon information supplied by the applicant at the time of application for certification. The game must be operated in accordance with the Law and Regulations, the specifications submitted by the applicant and the conditions set forth in this certification. Any modification of the specifications as submitted at the time of application or the conditions set forth herein shall immediately void the Certification of Permissibility for any game so operated.

It is unlawful to license or operate any amusement game in the State of New Jersey without a valid Certification of Permissibility or in a manner not in accordance with Certification of Permissibility issued for the game. DESCRIPTION:

"Skilo" is a Bingo like game in which a player purchases a card(s) bearing numbers or other designations five or more in one line. The players cover numbers or other designations on the card purchased as determined by where the indicator or wheel rests after being spun. The wheel or face upon which the indicator spins bears numbers or other designations identical to the numbers or other designations on the card(s) purchased by the player. The winner(s) being the player(s) who first completes a previously determined arrangement of numbers or other designations on their card.

DEFINITIONS:

“Card” means the card containing numbers or other designators, five or more on one line, identical to those on the wheel or surface upon which the indicator spins

“Indicator” means the apparatus which rests in a section of a wheel or surface containing the number or other designator identical to those on the cards purchased by players.

“Obstruction” means any portion of the stand/structure, any light or other type fixture, any box, bag, prize or other material.

“Playfield” means the area where a player sits or stands while playing, the card bearing numbers or other designators and any table or shelf upon which the card may be placed by the player while playing the game.

“Prize Category” means a prize, or group of prizes of comparable value, available to a player upon completion of the task necessary to win a prize in a particular category or available to a player by “trade up.”

“Prize category designation” means the identifier of one of the six authorized prize categories prescribed by condition 9 of this Certification of Permissibility or the point value posted on the merchandise.

“Professional quality” means that the surface of the sign to be used must be smooth and rigid in nature and not made from paper or corrugated cardboard, unless laminated.

“Round of play” means the sale of a right to participate, the event which determines whether the player wins or loses and the award of the prize.

“Stand/structure” means any stand, structure, booth, tent, trailer or area in which the game is operated.

“Trade up” means trading multiple prizes of a lower prize category for a prize in a higher prize category.

CONDITIONS:

- 1.) The maximum price to play shall not exceed values set forth in N.J.A.C. 13:3-.3.4.
- 2.) When the indicator arm of the spinner or the wheel rests on a number or other designator which has already been selected in the game being played, the next number or designator in a clockwise direction, which has not been selected in that game shall be considered selected. The caller shall vocally announce that number or designation.
- 3.) When more than one player is found to be the winner on the call of the same number in the same game, the designated prize shall be divided as equally as possible; and when division is not possible, substitute prizes, whose aggregate value shall not exceed that of the designated prize, shall be awarded; but such substitute prizes shall be of equal value to each other.

- 4.) If it is determined that two or more players have won a game on identical cards containing the same permutation number in the center free space or the identical arrangement of numbers (duplicate cards), the licensee shall consider all such winners as one winner and divide the prize accordingly. If all winners of the game have won on duplicate cards, each winner shall be paid the full prize amount offered as if he/she had won the prize alone.
- 5.) All prizes displayed must be available to be won either in a single round of play or by trading up through continued play.
- 6.) All prizes available though the play of the game shall be conspicuously displayed
- 7.) Prizes displayed shall be labeled to indicate prize category or points required to redeem the prize . Prizes shall be labeled individually or as a clearly delineated group of the same prize category.
- 8.) The maximum number of prize categories shall be six (6).
- 9.) Prize categories from the lowest to highest in values shall only be known, referred to, designated, or labeled as : Small; Medium; Large; X-Large; Jumbo or Choice.
- 10) The maximum number of prizes required in order to trade up to the next higher prize category shall be three (3). (IE: Three Small prizes are required to trade up to one Medium prize. Three Medium prizes are required to trade up to one Large prize. Three Large prizes are required to trade up to one X-Large prize. Three X- Large prizes are required to trade up to one Jumbo prize. Three Jumbo prizes are required to trade up to one Choice prize.)
- 11.) A notice shall be conspicuously post in the premises where skilo is played, listing the amounts of the charges an opportunity to play and for any other service or privilege offered. The notice shall also describe the nature and point value of prizes to be awarded.
- 12,) The card used by the player shall be part of a deck, group or series of cards, no two of which shall contain the same number pattern. No deck, group or series of cards shall be prepared or arranged as to prefer any card.
- 13.) The particular arrangement of numbers required to be covered in order to win the game shall be clearly described and announced to the players immediately before each game is begun.
- 14.) No arrangement of numbers required to be covered in order to win the game shall require a player to cover fewer than four numbers on any one card.
- 15.) No arrangement of numbers required to be covered in order to win the game shall require the use of more than four cards.
- 16.) An illustration of the arrangement of numbers required to win the game shall be clearly visible to all players during the conduct of the game.
- 17.) When a caller has started vocally to announce a selected number or other designator, the announcement of that number or other designator shall be completed.

- 18.) After the number or other designator is selected, if any person shall have completed the required arrangement of numbers or other designators required to be covered in order to win the game on his/her card based upon a number or other designator previously selected in that game, such person shall share the designated prize with any other person or persons who has completed the winning arrangement of numbers or other designators on his/her card based upon that selected number or designator .
- 19.) When a winner of a game is determined, the caller shall announce to the players present, "Are there any other winners?" If there are no other winners, the caller shall then state, "I declare this game closed", and shall proceed to award the prize.
- 20.) No person shall be entitled to share the designated prize unless he/she shall have completed the required arrangement of numbers or other designators required to be covered in order to win the game on his/her card and his/her is card determined to be a winner prior to the announcement that the game has been closed .
- 21.) The spinner or wheel used to select the number or other designator to be covered on a players card shall be under the control of a player at all times during game play. A licensee may control the activation of player positions. No licensee shall activate or deactivate a spinner or wheel used to select the number or other designator to be covered on a player's card.

This Certification of Permissibility is not a license to operate the captioned gambling device. The game must be licensed in accordance with the Law and Regulations.

The Commission reserves the right to suspend, revoke or modify this Certification of Permissibility upon notice to the manufacturer, operator and/or applicant.
